

ICE Technical Service Grants

Indigenous Clean Energy (ICE) offers one-time funding to support Indigenous-led clean energy projects, called **ICE Technical Service Grants**. These grants help cover the cost of a technical service that can move a project forward—such as team capacity building, project planning, design, engineering, or research. The goal is to help communities take meaningful next steps in their clean energy journey by offsetting costs and connecting with experienced service providers.



Grants are available on an ongoing basis, depending on funding availability. The value of each grant will vary based on the applicant's needs and the scope of the work, but may be up to **\$10,000**.

The funding is intended for services that make a real impact on a project's success. This could include solar or wind assessments, energy modelling, grid connection studies, or other expert support.

The service must directly benefit an Indigenous-led clean energy project. A signed service contract is required to apply. If funding goes directly to the service provider, they must also sign an ICE agreement that outlines their responsibilities.
